SUBJECT: STUDENTS WITH RE-SIT CASES.

It has been observed that some students (2018 admission cohort and earlier) had requested to be given re-sit examinations for courses they had failed during Year Three Semester I (3.1) studies of the 2020/2021 AY but were unable to retake during the First Semester of 2021/2022 AY since these students were officially out of session as some of their year mates had proceeded for Attachment/Teaching Practice exercises.

This is to inform all affected students that your request to take a re-sit has been approved by Senate and these examinations will be administered starting from Monday 5th September to Friday 9th September 2022.

Kindly note that it is only those courses a student had failed during Semester I of Year 3 which have been approved for re-sits.

Any student who has a failed course(s) in earlier year(s) is advised to retake the course when next offered.

You are however advised to liaise with your COD to confirm that your re-sit request for the course(s) has been approved.
